Main Site Afterschool Program Policies & Frequently Asked Questions

Parent/Guardian, please initial each question acknowledging you have read and understand the Main Site policies.

What does the Boys & Girls Club of Moorpark (BGC of Moorpark) Main Site do?

The Boys & Girls Club of Moorpark currently offers an Afterschool Program at the Main Site, 200 Casey Road. The program is open to all students in grades 1-5. The program is staffed by trained program professionals. The objective of our program is to provide safe and educationally enriching activities for youth during non-school hours. Our activities are designed to enhance the school's core curriculum and help students perform at grade level. We work together to broaden the base of support for education in a safe, constructive environment. Students participate in planned, educational based activities as well as structured, outdoor/fitness activities and only have "free-choice activities" at the end of the day during check-out time. Students also participate in Boys & Girls Club National programs. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

What are the days & hours of operation for the BGC of Moorpark Main Site?

The BGC of Moorpark Main Site is open to Club Members on school days, Monday through Friday from afterschool to 7:00pm. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

What is the program fee?

Fees are collected on a monthly basis. Fees are due on the 1st of each month. Any fees collected after the 5th of the month are considered LATE and could result in your child being removed from the program.

Where do I make my payments?

Payments can be made at the Administrative Office (4263 Tierra Rejada Rd. Moorpark 93021) Monday-Friday between 9:00AM and 5:30PM OR at the Main Site when you pick-up your child from the Club.

_____ (parent/guardian initial)

Does my child have to be a Boys & Girls Club of Moorpark Member before he/she can sign-up for any programs?

Yes! Each child must become a BGC of Moorpark Member before being able to sign-up for any BGC of Moorpark programs. The fee is \$25 per child. Each child is also required to have a current membership application on file.

Memberships are valid for one calendar year. ALL memberships must be renewed after the first of each year (all memberships expire December 31st). _____ (parent/guardian initial)

When can I pick-up my child?

Pick-up from our program begins at 5:00pm and goes until closing at 7:00pm. If you pick your child up before 5:00pm, we cannot guarantee your child has had time to work on their homework. Most Club Members are picked-up between 5:30pm-6:30pm. Please do not pick up your child before 5:00pm unless they have a previously scheduled appointment or activity (i.e. doctor's appointment, soccer practice, dance, tutor, etc.)

How many days per week does my child have to attend the BGC of Moorpark Main Site?

Each Club Member MUST attend at least three days per week. We greatly encourage participation a full five days a week. If attendance becomes less than 3 days per week consistently, your child may be removed from the program. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

Is homework time (Power Hour) mandatory?

Yes, working on homework is mandatory. Our Staff are available to assist with assignments and check for accuracy. All groups will have at least 45-60 minutes for homework at some point in the afternoon. Homework

should be completed during designated homework time. Students work on homework during one of the first few rotations. Students have a break when they arrive at the Club afterschool and participate in open gym time before beginning homework. If your child is picked up before 5:00pm, he/she may miss homework time. Please be sure you are assisting your child in making sure they bring their homework with them each day to BGC of Moorpark so that they can take advantage of our homework time. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

My child goes to Walnut Canyon. How will my child get to the BGC of Moorpark Main Site afterschool?

Each day two BGC of Moorpark Main Site staff will meet Walnut Canyon Club Members afterschool in front of campus by the flag pole. Club Members will check-in with the staff. Once all Walnut Canyon Club Members are accounted for, the group will walk next door to the BGC of Moorpark Main Site. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

My child goes to Mountain Meadows or Flory. How will my child get to the BGC of Moorpark Main Site afterschool?

You will need to sign your child up for our Transportation Program. Each day afterschool our BGC of Moorpark van driver will pick up your child from school and drive them to the BGC of Moorpark Main Site. There is a separate registration form for the Transportation Program, so please be sure to fill that out and turn it in with the attached Afterschool Program paperwork. There is limited space on the van, and acceptance is not guaranteed.

_____ (parent/guardian initial)

My child goes to Peach Hill. How will my child get to the BGC of Moorpark Main Site afterschool?

You will need to sign your child up for our Transportation Program. Each day afterschool your child will check-in at the front of the school with a BGC of Moorpark Staff. Once all Club Members are accounted for, the group and our staff will walk just around the corner to Peach Hill Park where they will wait for the van to pick them up and drive them to the Main Site. There is a separate registration form for the Transportation Program, so please be sure to fill that out and turn it in with the attached Afterschool Program paperwork. There is limited space on the van, and acceptance is not guaranteed. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

Should I send a snack with my child to have at the Club?

A snack is provided each day by the BGC of Moorpark Main Site. Students are encouraged to bring extra snacks if still hungry or on a special diet. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

Can my child bring toys or electronics from home?

NO! Please leave ALL toys and electronics at home. The only exception may be on some Fridays, but the Site Coordinator will give permission ahead of time. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

My child takes medication during the day. Who should I give it to?

All medications should be given to the Site Coordinator with a doctor's note that must include the following: The child's name, medication name, dosage amount, times the medication should be administered, doctor's name and phone number. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

What is the BGC of Moorpark Main Site's behavior policy?

Students are expected to follow the same behavior policy upheld during the regular school day. Inappropriate and harmful behavior/language will not be tolerated. _____ (parent/guardian initial)

If I turn in this enrollment form, will my child be guaranteed a spot in the program?

No, enrollment in the program is not guaranteed. Previous enrollment (and attendance), academic need and family need will all be considered along with the date the application is turned in. *Families will be notified by June 30th of their student's official enrollment.* _____ (parent/guardian initial)

What is the late pick-up policy?

Club members picked-up after 7:00pm are considered LATE, and will be charged a LATE FEE of \$1 per minute after 7pm per child. For example, if you pick up your child at 7:05pm, you will be charged a \$5 late fee. *If the Club has not heard from the parents by 7:30pm, members will be picked up by the Moorpark Police Department for their safety.* _____ (parent/guardian initial)

What if my child gets picked-up early from school or is out sick and will not be attending the BGC of Moorpark Main Site for the day?
