#### 2024-25 School Year Program Information

Thank you for your interest in the Boys & Girls Club as an after school enrichment program for your child. We also have programs during winter, spring breaks and in-service days. Activities include homework help, STEAM, social emotional learning (SEL), arts, healthy choices, leadership, and much more. The Club provides a safe, affordable place for kids to thrive, with caring, professional staff. All staff are pre-screened and complete fingerprint and background checks. They also receive extensive training in youth development. All site locations have first aid/CPR/AED certified staff.

Program Hours - All Club Sites are open from once school is dismissed until 6:00 pm each day.

Payments: All payments are due on the 1st of the month. A special discount is available if paid by the 25th of the prior month. All program participants must have current membership on file (\$25 per calendar year.) Payments can be made at the Admin Office at the Simi Valley Clubhouse (805) 527-4437. Credit card payments by phone are also accepted.

**Late Pick-up Fees:** All Club sites close at 6:00 pm. Due to the cost of staffing, a fee of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed five minutes after closing (6:05 pm).

Scholarships: Scholarships are available for qualified participants. Applications are available upon request.

**Van Transportation:** Van transportation is available from most of Simi Valley Schools (No pick up available for Wood Ranch, Madera or Knolls). Spaces fill quickly and are available on a first-come first-served basis. If such transportation is needed, please complete a Van Transportation Form.

**Medication:** Should your child need medications while attending the Club, an "Authorization to Administer Medication" form must be completed. All medications are stored in a locked location. Please see your child's Site Coordinator.

**Snacks:** A daily healthy snack is provided to all members. The Club does not provide any nut-based snacks. Please indicate on your child's registration form if he/she has any food or non-food allergies.

**Bully-Free Zone:** All Site locations are "bully-free" zones. We work hard to ensure that each Club member has a positive, fun experience and our Staff will listen and respond to any type of bullying. Inappropriate behavior and language is not tolerated. Please notify your child's Site Coordinator if you have any incidents or concerns.

**Valuables (Cell phones, Toys, Trading Cards, etc.):** The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen items that are brought to the Club. We encourage them to leave such items at home.

**Parent Handbook**: Parent Handbooks are available on our website and at each location. This has more information on our organization and our policies. We ask that parents review this for important information.

**Member Behavior Expectations:** All Club Sites follow the same guidelines and behavior policies as the regular school day. Members are expected to respect each other and respect Club property. The Club additionally has a "hands-off" policy, and any incidents including fighting (hitting, kicking etc.) will result in a one day suspension from the program.

Additional zero tolerance incidents include: biting, spitting, racial/homophobic slurs, leaving campus without permission, possessing weapons or drugs. These incidents result in automatic suspension.

### **VAN TRANSPORTATION POLICIES**

Please be aware that it is the goal of the Boys & Girls Club of Moorpark & Simi Valley to provide the highest quality of service to you and your family for the lowest cost possible. Safety is our #1 priority. All of our vehicles are inspected regularly and certified by the California Highway Patrol. All drivers are also trained and certified. Please read and initial the following:

Initials:	
	The Boys & Girls Club vans will meet your child immediately after school at a designated location. The driver will wait approximately 7 minutes after dismissal time when picking up. Please encourage your son/daughter to go directly to the van location. Should your child miss the van, they should go to the school office to notify the Club. We will make every effort to come back, however, there will be a \$25 fee for return pick-ups.
	Please notify the Club no later than 11:00 AM if your child will not be requiring a van pick up that day.
	If your child is absent from the van and you have not notified the Club of his/her absence, you will receive a follow-up call. These calls are made between 3:30 P.M. and 5:00 P.M.
	Our goal is to pick up all members in a timely manner. Wait times may vary due to early dismissal, conference schedules, etc. Your child must remain in the designated area in order not to miss the van.
	The safety of all Club members is our top priority. Any disciplinary issues with your child during the transportation time, may result in a non-refundable suspension of van service.
	Should you choose to discontinue van service, please provide a two week written drop notice to an office staff member at the Club. If no notice is provided, no refunds will be given for any remaining portion of the month that was paid.
