

2025-26 School Year Program Information

Thank you for your interest in the Boys & Girls Club as an after school enrichment program for your child. We also have programs during winter, spring breaks, and in-service days. Activities include homework help, STEAM, social emotional learning (SEL), arts, healthy choices, leadership, and much more. The Club provides a safe, affordable place for kids to thrive, with caring, professional staff. All staff are pre-screened and complete fingerprint and background checks. They also receive extensive training in youth development. All site locations have first aid/CPR/AED-certified staff.

The objective of our after-school programs is to provide safe and educationally enriching activities for youth during non-school hours. Our activities are designed to enhance the school's core curriculum and help students perform at grade level. The Club works with Moorpark Unified School District to broaden the base of support for education in a safe, constructive environment. Students participate in planned, education-based activities as well as structured, outdoor/fitness activities, and only have "free-choice activities" at the end of the day during check-out time. Students also participate in Boys & Girls Clubs of America (BGCA) National programs as well as localized, school-based after school enrichment programs and activities.

Before School Hours - Our Arroyo West and Campus Canyon sites provide before-school care from 7:00 am - the start of the school day. A minimum of 20 students are needed to provide this Morning Service

Payments: All payments are due on the 1st of the month. A special discount is available if paid by the 25th of the prior month. All program participants must have a current membership on file (\$25 per calendar year.) Payments can be made at all site locations (cash or check) or at the Admin Office at the Moorpark Clubhouse (805) 529-1140. Credit card payments by phone are also accepted.

Late Pick-up Fees: All Club sites close at 6:00 pm. Due to the cost of staffing, a fee of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed five minutes after closing (6:05 pm).

Scholarships: Scholarships are available for qualified participants. Applications are available upon request.

Van Transportation: Van transportation is available from Peach Hill and Flory Schools to our Moorpark Clubhouse. Spaces fill quickly and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. If such transportation is needed, please complete a Van Transportation Form.

Medication: Should your child need medications while attending the Club, an "<u>Authorization to Administer Medication</u>" form must be completed. All medications are stored in a locked location. Please see your child's Site Coordinator.

Snacks: A daily healthy snack is provided to all members. The Club does not provide any nut-based snacks. Please indicate on your child's registration form if he/she has any food or non-food allergies.

Triple Play

Members participate in BGCA's national fitness program, Triple Play prior to homework each day. Club members will stretch, play games, exercise, and have fun!

Homework (Power Hour)

"Power Hour", homework assistance occurs every day after school. This is a great time for our members to get a head start on Homework, where our Staff are available to assist with assignments and check for accuracy. If you would like your child to complete their homework daily or are in need of extra assistance, please let our front counter staff know, and we will be glad to assist!

Enrichment Clubs

Friday enrichment clubs give our members an opportunity to select a program of their interest. Members can select to participate in a variety of options that rotate every six weeks. Options include Boys & Girls Club of America's national programs along with a number of locally developed programs such as Leadership Club, Journalism Club, and STEAM activities. **Bully-Free Zone:** All Site locations are "bully-free" zones. We work hard to ensure that each Club member has a positive, fun experience, and our Staff will listen and respond to any type of bullying. Inappropriate behavior and language are not tolerated. Please notify your child's Site Coordinator if you have any incidents or concerns.

Valuables (Cell phones, Toys, Trading Cards, etc.): The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen items that are brought to the Club. We encourage them to leave such items at home.

Parent Handbook: Parent Handbooks are available on our website and at each location. This has more information on our organization and our policies. We ask that parents review this for important information.

Member Behavior Expectations

All Site locations follow the same guidelines and behavior policies as the regular school day at each school. Please refer to your child's school handbook. This includes, but is not limited to, dress code, code of ethics, cell phones, safety rules, etc.

In addition to the school guidelines, members are expected to:

- 1. Be Safe (stay with the group, walk)
- 2. Be Respectful (Walk through the halls quietly)
- 3. Be Responsible (Pay attention to where your group is going)
- 4. Make Good Choices (Keep your hands and feet to yourself)

Minor incidents are documented if a student is removed from his/her group. Parents/Guardians will be notified which may result in a member being sent home and potentially suspended.

The Club additionally has a "hands-off" policy, and any incidents including fighting (hitting, kicking etc.) will result in a two day suspension from the program. Additional zero tolerance incidents include: biting, spitting, racial/homophobic slurs, leaving campus without permission, possessing weapons or drugs. These incidents result in automatic suspension. After three (3) suspensions of any kind, a student may be expelled from the Boys & Girls Club.
