2025-26 School Year Program Information

Thank you for your interest in the Boys & Girls Club as an after school enrichment program for your child. We also have programs during winter, spring breaks and in-service days. Activities include homework help, STEAM, social emotional learning (SEL), arts, healthy choices, leadership, and much more. The Club provides a safe, affordable place for kids to thrive, with caring, professional staff. All staff are pre-screened and complete fingerprint and background checks. They also receive extensive training in youth development. All site locations have first aid/CPR/AED certified staff.

The objective of our after-school programs is to provide safe and educationally enriching activities for youth during non school hours. Our activities are designed to enhance the school's core curriculum and help students perform at grade level. The Club works with Moorpark Unified School District to broaden the base of support for education in a safe, constructive environment. Students participate in planned, educational based activities as well as structured, outdoor/fitness activities and only have "free-choice activities" at the end of the day during check-out time. Students also participate in Boys & Girls Clubs of America (BGCA) National programs as well as localized, school-based after school enrichment programs and activities.

Program Hours - All Club Sites are open from School dismissal until 6:00 pm each day.

Before School Hours - Our Arroyo West and Campus Canyon sites provide before-school care from 7:00 am - the start of the school day. A minimum of 20 students are needed to provide this Morning Service

Payments: All payments are due on the 1st of the month. A special discount is available if paid by the 25th of the prior month. All program participants must have current membership on file (\$25 per calendar year.) Payments can be made at all site locations (cash or check) or at the Admin Office at the Moorpark Clubhouse (805) 529-1140. Credit card payments by phone are also accepted.

Late Pick-up Fees: All Club sites close at 6:00 pm. Due to the cost of staffing, a fee of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed five minutes after closing (6:05 pm).

Scholarships: Scholarships are available for qualified participants. Applications are available upon request.

Van Transportation: Van transportation is available from Peach Hill and Flory Schools to our Moorpark Clubhouse. Spaces fill quickly and are available on a first-come first-served basis. If such transportation is needed, please complete a Van Transportation Form.

Medication: Should your child need medications while attending the Club, an "Authorization to Administer Medication" form must be completed. All medications are stored in a locked location. Please see your child's Site Coordinator.

Snacks: A daily healthy snack is provided to all members. The Club does not provide any nut-based snacks. Please indicate on your child's registration form if he/she has any food or non-food allergies.

Bully-Free Zone: All Site locations are "bully-free" zones. We work hard to ensure that each Club member has a positive, fun experience and our Staff will listen and respond to any type of bullying. Inappropriate behavior and language is not tolerated. Please notify your child's Site Coordinator if you have any incidents or concerns.

Valuables (Cell phones, Toys, Trading Cards, etc.): The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen items that are brought to the Club. We encourage them to leave such items at home.

Parent Handbook: Parent Handbooks are available on our website and at each location. This has more information on

our organization and our policies. We ask that parents review this for important information.

Member Behavior Expectations

All Site locations follow the same guidelines and behavior policies as the regular school day at each school. Please refer to your child's school handbook. This includes, but is not limited to dress code, code of ethics, cell phones, safety rules, etc.

In addition to the school guidelines, members are expected to:

1. Be Safe (stay with the group, walk)
2. Be Respectful (Walk through the halls quietly)
3. Be Responsible (Pay attention to where your group is going)
4. Make Good Choices (Keep your hands and feet to yourself)

Minor incidents are documented if a student is removed from his/her group. Parents/Guardians will be notified and may result in a member being sent home and potentially suspended.

The Club additionally has a "hands-off" policy, and any incidents including fighting (hitting, kicking etc.) will result in a two day suspension from the program. Additional zero tolerance incidents include: biting, spitting, racial/homophobic slurs, leaving campus without permission, possessing weapons or drugs. These incidents result in automatic suspension. **After three (3) suspensions of any kind, a student will be expelled from the Boys & Girls Club.**

_____ For my child's safety, I understand that I and all contacts on my child's membership application, will be required to show proper identification to pick up my son/daughter. Members will not be released to any person(s) who do not have written authorization on file.

_____ Late Pick-up Fee - All Club sites close at 6:00 pm. Due to the cost of staffing, a fee of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed five minutes after closing (6:05 pm).

_____ I understand that my child may be selected to participate in various local walking field trips and I give my permission for my child to participate in such events. This includes, but is not limited to, walking trips to the park for lunch time and special events activities.

_____ I understand all payments are to be paid no later than the 1st of the month. All field trip sign ups are on a first-come, first-served basis and are confirmed with payment. Payment should be received no later than **two business** days prior to the field trip or interest club (i.e. dance, glee, etc.).

_____ Split households: Full payment must be made at time of registration. No partial payments accepted on any fees applied. This includes monthly payments.

_____ I understand that any request for a credit or refund request must be received 5 business days in advance, by the Admin Office. Refunds or credits due to sick days are not available.

_____ Returned Check Fee - A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any returned check. Additional occurrences may result in no longer accepting payment in check form.

_____ I understand the BGC Parent Handbook is available to me on the Club website and at all Club Sites. I further understand that it is my responsibility to be familiar with its contents, and abide by the program requirements and parent responsibilities outlined in it.

_____ I understand that the Club works closely with the Moorpark Unified School District to maximize the impact of Club programs. PROGRAM HOURS CRITERIA:

Students are expected to attend a minimum of 15 hours per week to maintain eligibility in the ASES program.

Early Release / Excused Absences:

Early pick up is allowed for the following reasons:

- When your child has a documented medical reason (such as: doctor, dentist, counseling, etc)
- Is sick (ill or has a family emergency)
- Is participating in a parallel program (such as: tutoring, organized sports practice, dance, religious class, etc.).
- Is participating in a school or family event.
- Other: There may be other circumstances such as adverse weather conditions, that occur during program time that may affect the safety of your child or other program participants. In such cases, please notify the Site Coordinator & provide a note detailing the reason your child is being picked up early from the after-school program.

Please remember that regular attendance is critical to the positive growth of all program participants. Your Site Coordinator will assist you in monitoring weekly attendance. Unexcused absences may lead to dismissal from the ASES program.

Please be sure to communicate planned absences or early release with your Site Coordinator ahead of time. Written documentation is required. A parent note may be collected at time of pick up.

PARENT AGREEMENT:

The ASES After School Program runs daily from school dismissal until 6:00 p.m. Regular attendance of **15 hours** per week is expected to meet the attendance criteria.

If I have an "Excused Absence," I will notify the Site Coordinator within 48 Hours. **Please initial here** _____

Daily check-out time begins three hours after school dismissal and ends at 6:00 p.m. All members in the program must be signed out daily. I will sign out my child on a daily basis. **Please initial here** _____

I understand that the safety of all members is our #1 priority. Behavior challenges, disrespectful or other inappropriate behavior may result in disciplinary action. Continuous behavioral issues may result in your child's removal from the program. Please discuss any concerns with the Site Coordinator. My child will follow all program rules.
